A display of the Players' wonderful archives can be seen in the Museum in Kaleidoscope at Sevenoaks Library until December.



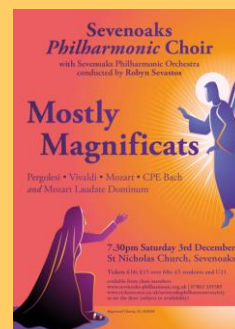
